ACS FUNDING

- Part of the decennial census; included in Periodic Censuses and Programs account
- Fiscal Year 2012
 - o Census Bureau: \$888.3m
 - Periodic Censuses: \$635.0m
 - x 2020 Decennial Census: \$66.6m
 - o Salaries & Expenses: \$253.3m

ACS FUNDING (con't.)

- Fiscal Year 2013
 - Started on October 1, 2012, under a Continuing Funding Resolution that expires on March 27, 2013
 - Federal agencies funded at FY2012 levels
 - "Sequestration" tied to deficit reduction deal could reduce FY2013 funding by additional 5 percent; scheduled to take effect March 1, 2013, barring congressional action

ACS RESPONSE: Mandatory vs. Optional

- House passed amendment to FY2013 appropriations bill making response to ACS voluntary instead of mandatory
- 2003 field test of voluntary ACS: Response rates drop "dramatically" (20%) and cost increases significantly (30%, or \$60M at time of test)
- Diminished reliability of ACS data puts 3-year and 5-year estimates at risk
